Fairways have been fertilized so things will be greening up. Irrigation up and running after installing a pressure tank in pump house, old tank rusted through the bottom. New one is fiberglass no rust.

Outdoor pool area is being made ready for the opening day. Lots of extra work for the golf course crew.
