

HNSC MEETING NOTES
May 27, 2016

Attending: Carol, Judy, Wendy, Valerie, Pat, Denny, Ginny, Carolyn, Nancy, Patricia, Peg, Danielle, Peggy, Barbara

Treasurer's Report: Peggy verified receipt of \$1,500 from KCCA. The previous balance was \$386. Current balance is \$1,886 before any reimbursements are distributed. The cost of food for BYOB was; January \$187, February \$148, March \$252, April \$235, May \$314.

Purchase of BBQ: Peggy passed around print-outs describing gas or electric BBQ's the group could purchase. The advantages/disadvantages of this purchase were discussed. HNSC could help pay for a larger, more substantial BBQ if purchased by KCCA for the use of the community. The group felt that an outsider renting the facility should not have use of the BBQ. Cleaning after its use should be the responsibility of the group using it. It was mentioned that there was a possibility a KCCA resident may have an appropriate BBQ that is no longer being used. Denny mentioned that he might be able to donate his Jennair BBQ to KCCA after consultation with his wife. Valerie will post a notice asking if any KCCA member has a propane 2 burner (at least) BBQ and is willing to sell it to KCCA/HNSC.

Cinco de Mayo BYOB: This was a very successful event. Approximately 75 people attended, many of whom were new. All seemed to be having a wonderful time and there were many positive comments about the music and food.

Home'n'Home Golf Tournament Luncheon: This will take place June 6th at the Clubhouse. Volunteers should arrive at 9-9:30am to set up. It is anticipated there will be approximately 40 golfers attending. Nancy will loan her BBQ for this event. Peggy will purchase meat, buns, chips, whipped cream, and beverages. He will also discuss set-up with Brian. Judy will provide 10# of potato salad, Wendy will make macaroni salad, Danielle will bring a bean dish, Nancy will make a desert and Judy will defrost the two pies left in her freezer from "Pies of March", Valerie will bring condiments, and Carolyn will provide lettuce, and sliced tomatoes,

pickles, and onions for the hamburgers. Carol will be in charge of 50/50 and Ginny will announce winners,

The next BYOB: “Summer by the Pool” theme, June 9, 2016, 5-7:00pm. Be there at 4:00pm to set up. Anticipate 80 attendees. Wendy displayed decorations of sand buckets and pinwheels. She requested people bring beach towels, shells, sunglasses, etc. to augment the decorations. HNSC members should wear beach hats, sunglasses, and other summery garb. Danielle will bring chicken wings, Valerie will research purchase of 6 foot hero sandwiches, possibly including vegetarian fare, Patricia will bring chips, Wendy will bring watermelon, Pat will provide a cucumber dish, and Carol will bring cabbage slaw. Barbara will purchase mini-ice cream desserts. Patricia will contact John Harkness to see if he can DJ the event featuring poolside-type music from the patio. The group should anticipate paying him at least \$50. Valerie and Carol will share 50/50 responsibilities.

July BYOB: This will be July 14th and will have a western theme. It was suggested that Betty Vanderpool’s brother-in-law’s Western band could provide music for this event.
