<u>Fairways:</u> We got the fertilizing done for the year. I had PST come in and sand all the areas that we have put drainage in. 132 tons of sand.

**Equipment:** With a few minor repairs all the leaf and limb recovery equipment are running well and hard at work along with the maintenance crew who work hard to keep common grounds and golf course looking it's best.
