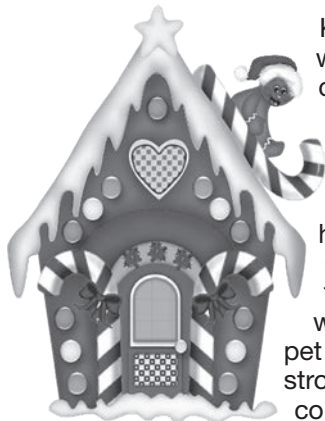

Merry Christmas, everyone!!!!  
 Wow! We're in the countdown to Christmas already. And before we know it, the 2019 golf season will be upon us!

Our Pro Shop and Golf Course operating winter hours of operation are 8 AM to 4 PM., 7 days a week. We will be open half day on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, closed on Christmas Day. We will be open for business on New Year's Day. During inclement weather, snow and ice, these hours could change.

Another couple of reminders are our winter rates are now in effect from now until February 28th. In addition, we still have Winter Golf Passes for sale at \$125 each.

The 2019 Golf Passes and Cart Trail passes are on sale. The Annual pass is \$419, and is valid from January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. The Season pass is \$319, and is valid from March 1, 2019 through October 31, 2019. Youth and Youth Team passes are \$95, and are valid from March 1 through September 30, 2019.

These would make a great Christmas gift idea when figuring out what to get that golfer or golfers in your life.

During those cold and somewhat dreary months ahead, we are adding "Comfort Food" to our menu. Instead of a plain hotdog, we are offering chili and grated cheese for your hotdog. Just pre-order what you would like, and we will have it ready for you within 45 minutes.

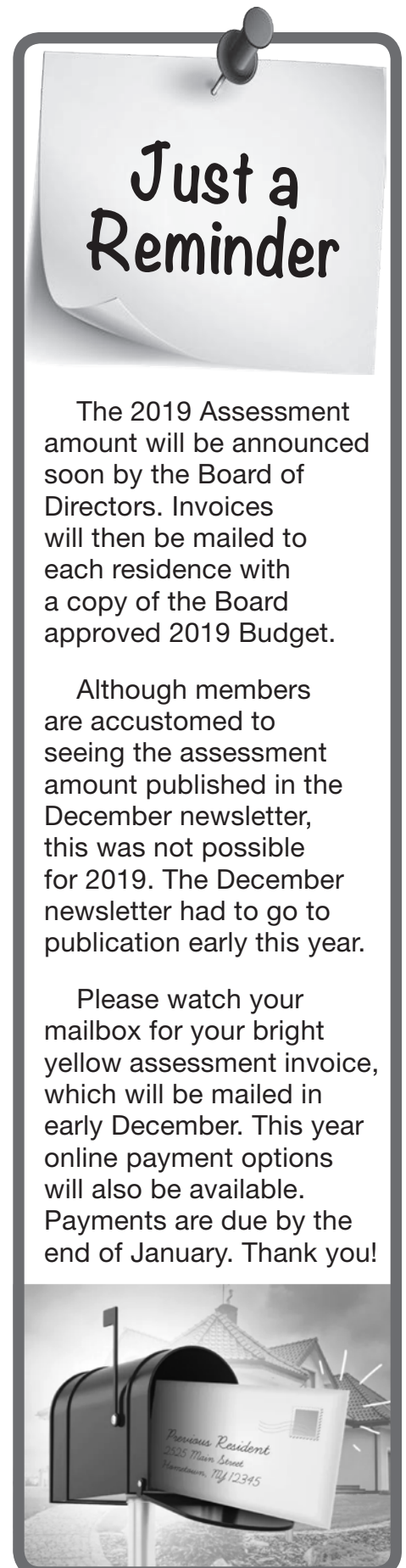

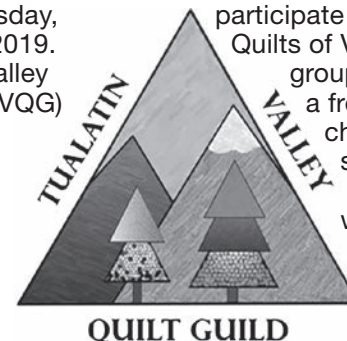
## Tualatin Valley Quilt Guild

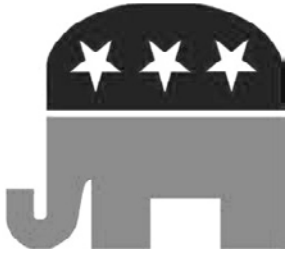
