The Amendment to Restated Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions of King City Civic Association is made by the King City Civic Association, Inc., an Oregon nonprofit corporation (the "Association").

RECITALS

C. Pursuant to Article XIII, Section 1 of the Restated Declaration, the Association's Board of Directors hereby amends the Restated Declaration in the manner set forth below.

I. Article VII, Section 9.A of the Declaration is amended as follows:

A. Rental Units. Unit must be permanently occupied only by an Owner or the immediate family of the Owner. Immediate family shall mean the Owner's spouse, children, brothers, sisters, parents, or grandparents. If title to a Unit is conveyed to an Owner's creditor, such creditor shall be entitled to rent or lease the Unit for a period not to exceed one (1) year following acquisition of title. Tenants of such Units must meet all requirements for residency and are subject to all Association Documents.
