Minors (under 18) 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. only

Guests are limited to four (4) per household.

Water Aerobics are Monday thru Friday: 10 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.

Note: The 9 a.m. start time is so that Jeff and his crew can clean and prepare the pool beforehand.

General Outdoor Pool Rules (partial list)

- Minors and guests must be accompanied by a <u>resident-member</u>.
- You must have a key <u>CARD</u> to enter. Your old metal key no longer works. If you haven't gotten your key card yet, you can get it at the KCCA Club House office. Some charges may apply. Do not loan or share your key card.
- Please sign in prior to entering the gate.

- As required by State Law, you must use the <u>Onsite Shower</u> before going into the pool, even if you showered before you came.
- THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY – USE ALL OF THE POOL FACILITIES AT YOUR OWN RISK.


Travel Club is heading West to the Columbia River Maritime Museum in Astoria Oregon


Wood Working Club
