August 5, 2016

Mission Statement

Financial: Peggy reported a current balance of \$2,339.79

Game Night Review: The event was poorly attended, but fun for the committee members and the guests who did come. It was felt that attendance would be greater if the event were to be held in the winter when weather keeps people indoors. Planning another game night after the holidays in January or February, perhaps following a soup dinner was suggested.

BYOB August 11, chaired by Patricia and Pat: Nancy bought 69 leis to be distributed to guests. Pat and Judy volunteered to be "greeters" to present them. Nancy bought six grass skirts to go around the food and beverage tables. Wendy will bring signs/posters and Carolyn will provide seashells for decorations. Patricia reports a musician, Francis Loo, ukulele, has been hired to play one hour. Hawaiian-type foods will be provided. Pat will bring coconut bars, Judy fresh fruit and creme, Peg teriyaki chicken wings, Danielle chicken salad, Peggy pulled pork, Nancy and Ginny Hawaiian punch (non-alcoholic), and Peggy Ritz-type crackers. There is a need for a second corkscrew and a way to keep it secure. Carol volunteered to again head up 50/50 ticket sales. Peggy, Ginny and Carol will be responsible for the drawing.

King City 50th Anniversary Golf Tournament and Car Show BBQ August 19 (be there at 9:30-10:00am: Approximately 130 guests are anticipated; 40 from the car show, 72 golfers, and HNSC committee members. It was decided to schedule lunch for people from the car show at noon and the golfers at 12:30pm. Nancy and Peggy will shop for all food (hamburgers, hot dogs, potato salad, baked beans, and cookies), beverages and other necessary items. Danielle offered to augment the purchased potato salad and Ginny displayed new BBQ "Wonder gloves" she bought for HNSC. Nancy will store frozen hamburger patties at home and will thaw them prior to the

event. **Nancy** has a new roll of tickets stored at her house and will bring it for the 50/50. It was reported that there was a need to provide a full propane tank for the BBQ.

A large Electric Griddle was donated to HNSC by Joe Wilson, KCCA Director: It will be stored in the HNSC cabinet and used for future pancake breakfasts, luncheon foods, etc. Thank you so much, Joe.

The group again discussed including a request for other donations from the community. A microphone, sound and/or karaoke equipment, etc. was mentioned.

Other events scheduled to celebrate King City's 50th Anniversary was discussed: **Nancy** passed out printed schedules for that week. The City of King City is organizing the events. HNSC is involved as a group only as previously discussed.

Cleaning/Organizing HNSC Cabinets: HNSC has acquired another cabinet and equipment and supplies need reorganization. This is tentatively scheduled **August 22nd at 10:00am** if the Banquet Room is not reserved. The date will be confirmed at the next meeting.
