Mission Statement

Should HNSC supervise other groups who might be interested in using the second Thursday for their own event? Should BYOBs be discontinued altogether? The discussion was tabled. The only conclusion reached was that, even if another group should host, since HNSC had reserved the venue it should be responsible for supervision of the hosting personnel in order to verify that appropriate cleaning and locking up is done, and to be available as a source of information to the hosting group.

This will be a true "Bring Your Own", as attendees will be expected to provide their own snacks and beverages.
