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## HELLO NEIGHBORS SOCIAL COMMITTEE MEETING NOTES

## February 3, 2017

**Mission Statement** 

"Hello Neighbors Social Committee's purpose is to enable the KCCA community to engage in warm and welcoming social activities while maximizing residents' involvement, initiating interactions and building new relationships."

Attending: Nancy, Patricia, Suzanne, Judy, Carol, Peg, Peggy, Carolyn

Financial: Current balance per Treasurer Peggy: \$1,813,13

**Game Night Recap:** Saturday 1/21 game night was attended by 10 guests and eight HNSC members. A good time was had by all. Peggy recommended a start time of 4:30 rather than 6:30pm. All agreed that an earlier start time would attract more participants.

**Next BYOB:** Feb. 9, 5-7:00pm. Be there at 4:00pm. **Carolyn** reported her schedule change that would prevent her from being available to help set up for the event, but that she would be there as soon as possible and would stay until lock up. All agreed that they would assist to cover her absence. It was agreed that it would be sufficient for **Suzanne** to provide 50 Valentine's cookies. **Patricia** will advertise the event on King Net and NextDoor. **Patricia** reported that entertainment is verified. As part of her presentation at the BYOB **Peggy** will ask for volunteers to host future BYOB events.

**BYOB - General Information: Judy** is in the process of calling clubs to ascertain interest in hosting future BYOB parties. Thus far, the Lawn Bowling group has committed to host the March BYOB and the Shuffleboard Club will host April's BYOB event. Members of HNSC will be available at all BYOB events to provide support. **Peggy** suggested that a very basic box of supplies (disposable plates, cups, napkins, dinnerware) be supplied by HNSC for use if needed by hosting groups. **The group agreed on this, but stipulated that if the hosting group needed special decorations or other items for their event, it would not be the responsibility of HNSC.** 

**Carol** suggested HNSC schedule a style show by the American Cancer Society's Discovery Shop followed by the BYOB, perhaps in the Fall. This was greeted with enthusiasm. **Carol** will obtain more information from the Discovery Shop and report next meeting. **Peggy** suggested a tea party follow the style show rather than BYOB and that it

be scheduled on a date separate from the BYOB event. This will obviously need more research.

**Pies of March:** Sunday March 12, 2-4:00pm. Be there at 12:30pm. Uncut pies to be delivered to the Clubhouse by 1:00pm.

**Peg** reported that Barbara Sherman, reporter from the "Courier" will attend. **Judy** and **Peg** will compose an article to advertise the event and request homemade pies for the event in the March "Courier". **Nancy** reported that ribbons to be presented to and worn by pie donors can be purchased online for \$1.90 to \$2.65 for 49 ribbons. It would cost less if more ribbons were



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purchased. Carolyn suggested a larger amount be purchased and stored for future uses. The group agreed. Nancy also reported that a white board could be purchased for \$19.39 and assorted erasable pens for \$6.00. The group agreed this would be an appropriate purchase. Carolyn suggested that this might be useful for other KCCA endeavors and that KCCA might be willing to pay for the white board for use by all KCCA entities. **Nancy** will research this. Last year, the KCCA office took responsibility for presale of tickets to Pies of March. This may still be possible: \$3.00 for one piece of pie and \$5.00 for two. Ice cream, whipped cream and beverages will be provided with the cost of the ticket. Kristina must be consulted about this added office responsibility. **Carol** volunteered to check in donated pies by 1:00pm, man the donor sign-in clipboard, and present the ribbons for pie donors to wear to the event. A white board will also display the names of pie donors. **Peggy** and **Carol** will sell tickets to the event at the door. It was suggested and agreed that an advertisement-type notice requesting the donation of pies be submitted to the "Courier and "Newsletter". Peg will be responsible for this. Judy is also suggesting pie donation when contacting KCCA's clubs. Pie donors must contact HNSC (Peggy or **Judy**) with their intent to donate a pie no later than March 1. Again, pies should be delivered uncut to the Clubhouse no later than 1:00pm the day of the event. The group will send thank you notes to donors.
