Mission Statement

New Residents Welcome Party: Many new residents did not attend, perhaps because of other summertime commitments. New residents who did not attend will receive a second invitation. It was mentioned that other residents need to know they are welcome as well. **Nancy** will include that information in future posters and fliers. Also, it was suggested that a realty-type sawhorse or two be purchased by Hello Neighbors to advertise events. These could be placed in front of the Clubhouse and perhaps the Proshop or Library building. They would be more noticeable to passers-by. **Elaine** volunteered to research the price of sawhorses.

National Night Out: This event was very successful. There were 67 or more attendees, including some of our first responders who, unfortunately, had their visit cut short due to their need to respond to a call. They were given a standing ovation as they departed. It was noted that adjustments were required due to larger attendance by some neighborhoods and smaller attendance by others. This is unavoidable and was managed smoothly. Color-coding of neighborhoods (tablecloth colors matching the neighborhood map) was a hit and should be continued.

Sundae Sunday: 80+ people attended this successful event. It was noted that next year there should be <u>two</u> chocolate as well as two vanilla ice cream tubs. This year the chocolate offering was chocolate fudge swirl - a real hit! It was suggested that the ice cream be separated from the toppings choices to avoid ice cream dripping into them. **Labor Day Potluck:** 64+ people attended. Trivia was a real hit again. Thank you **Mary Lou**. It was suggested that clean up be initiated by Hello Neighbors members and guests who know the schedule. Clean up by guests began earlier than necessary this year and people may have felt rushed. It was suggested that consolidation of dishes on the potluck tables and removal of empty dishes could be accomplished with minor disruption, whereas clearing tables and moving furniture too early can be

disruptive and distracts from the friendly welcoming atmosphere we are striving to encourage.

Future Events

October - Soup and Rolls: Members to provide soup - Nancy, Peggy Carolyn, Patricia, Dianne, and Steve. Mary Lou will bring cookies. Hello Neighbors will provide rolls and butter and beverages as usual. Decorations will celebrate Halloween - Peggy and Dianne will evaluate the decorations available.

Another musical concert will be November's offering. **Ginny** is planning to show <u>How the Grinch Stole Christmas</u> on December 20th. New Years Party: Ginny reports Micky Sievers will be available to entertain us on the piano.
