Election Season is Here!

The 2023 Board of Directors elections are fast approaching. There will be two board positions open this election cycle. If you'd like to run for one of them, there are two ways for you to get on the ballot.

The first way is to contact Bill Enyart, chair of the Nominating committee, at benyart@mykcca.com and let him know you'd like to be nominated.

The second way is to submit

a petition with signatures from a minimum of 25 resident members to the Association office. You can draw up your own petition, or you can use the petition form available at the KCCA office.

Finally, whether you're nominated by the Nominating committee or by submitting a petition, you should also submit a brief (approx 400 words) bio and a photo for the newsletter.

Here are the important dates for the 2023 election season:

- April 7:** Deadline to contact nominating committee or submit petition.
Deadline to submit bio and photo to KCCA office.
- April 11:** Candidates announced at BOD meeting.
- April 18:** Election signs can go up.
- May 12:** Ballots mailed out. You can vote as soon as you receive your ballot.
- May 20:** **Annual Membership meeting** - Meet the Candidates.
- May 25:** Recommended final day to mail ballots.
- June 6:** Election closes/online voting website closes.
- June 7:** Election results posted.
- June 13:** BOD meeting - new board is seated.

From the LARC Committee Chair

To all KCCA residents, It is the time of year when we will be coming around to view all properties.

We remind all to clear sidewalks and driveways of moss, weeds, etc.

It is time to prune trees, bushes, and hedges to maintain the standard of compliance.

Remember, shrubbery may be planted as long as it does not obstruct the view of the golf course from adjacent lots. On all lots, no hedge, fence, wall, or shrubbery shall exceed three (3) feet in height on the portion of the lot between the setback line of the house and the street, including corner lots and cul-de-sacs. This must conform with the standards of the City of King City regarding visibility clearance at the intersections and sidewalks. Shrubby, trees, plants, etc., within four (4) feet of the house's foundation may exceed the three (3) feet limitation. On the remainder of the lot, the maximum height shall be (6) feet.
