A follow-up on pool rules has been suggested:

The pool is open from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m., and children are allowed from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. only. Note: Children must be potty trained, and swim diapers are not allowed in the pool.

Please sign in. Print your name, key card number and guests clearly.

No eating in the pool area. Glass containers are not allowed. The table and chairs outside the pool area are available for eating.

It is important that the floating rope be in place except for lap swimming. No hanging on, standing on or pulling on the rope is allowed.

Please don't block the blue board rules with tables, chairs or lounges. Thank you for observing the rules. They are there for your safety.

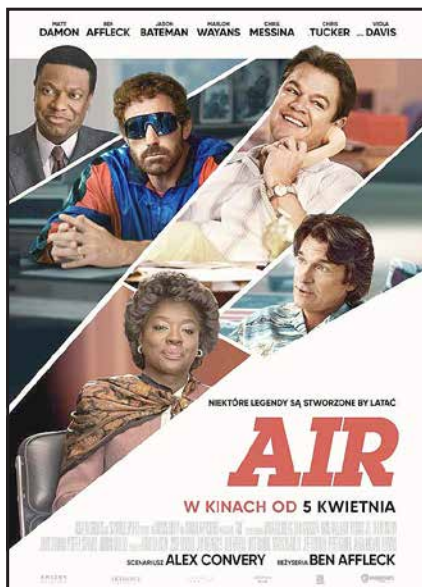
