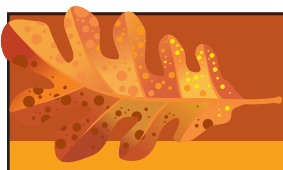

The “Chicklets” will back up Chick on “Hey Good Looking,” and Chick, Duane, Tom and

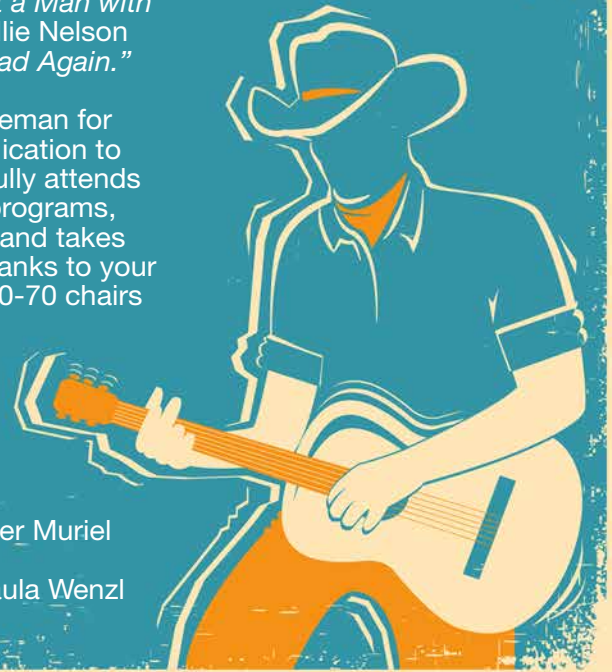

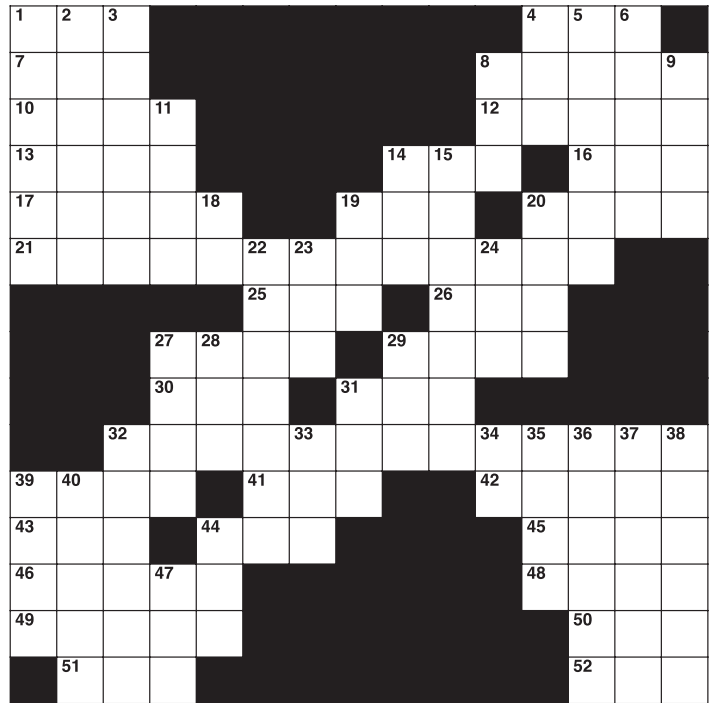
