## **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

Doraine Bault (Croquet): No report

Jeff Halfman (Golf Course Superintendent): Jeff gave brief explanation of why sprinkler operation is erratic at times. All course sprinklers are controlled by 12 controllers which are 21 years old. Bugs, slugs, ants and other insects creep past controller seals, short out circuit boards and periodic maintenance (removal, cleaning, calibration and installation) is required for proper sprinkler system operation. No circuit boards have suffered damage this year. Dirt removed from pond dredging is being molded into a mound and area will be hydro seeded soon. Jeff will be monitoring weather in hopes of aerating greens and applying a light coat of sand to minimize burning and dry spots on greens this summer.

David Mack (Lawn Bowling): Everything is going well

Joy Olmstead (Pro Shop Manager): Weather has created some revenue issues, play is slow but we are seeing an increase in rounds played over last year. Working with Lion's Club for a possible tournament in August. Still looking for course marshals.
