“Celebrate what you want to see more of.” Happy New Year!

The LARC Committee will be celebrating KCCA's mission of a neat, attractive community. Our property values are strong, and LARC is committed to keeping them vibrant. But it's a team effort and each homeowner needs to be a team player, support and follow KCCA rules and regulations, and foster community pride and belonging. Each of us made this promise when we purchased our homes and agreed to KCCA's Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (C, C & Rs).

Here's how you may help:

- Familiarize yourself with our CC & Rs available on the KCCA website under Governing Documents, CC & Rs and at the KCCA Office.
- Any work to the outside of your property (roofing, painting, fencing, etc.) requires approval via a LARC Project Request Form. Additional approval may

be required by King City. The form is available via the KCCA website and at the KCCA office.

- If a contractor needs to place a dumpster on the street adjacent to your property, King City requires a street permit for the dumpster. The dumpster must be marked with visibly reflective markings and reflective cones.
- Maintain your yard by pruning bushes and trees, controlling weeds, planting “Street Wise” trees, removing debris and keeping grass cut. Note – evergreen trees are not street-wise and should not be planted on the front of your property. If you need a list of “Street Wise” trees, please contact LARC – Mary Maney, mkmaney01@msn.com.
- Remove weeds and moss from curbs and sidewalks that abut your property.
- Place trash receptacles no



more than 2 feet apart on the street along the curb (not on the sidewalk) and remove them once trash is collected.

- Maintain your lamppost and ensure the lamp is lit and visible.
- RVs and trailers, including utility trailers, may only be parked on or adjacent to your property for a maximum of seventy-two (72) hours.

FYI – LARC will only meet 1X (one time) per month through March until further notice. After the New Year, we will be reviewing property lampposts and placing green ribbons on posts that need to be repaired or put in working order.

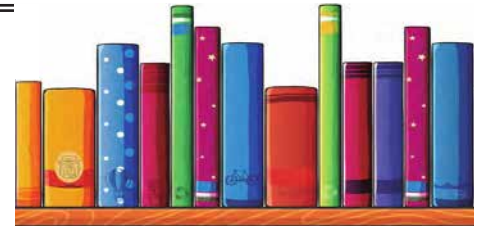

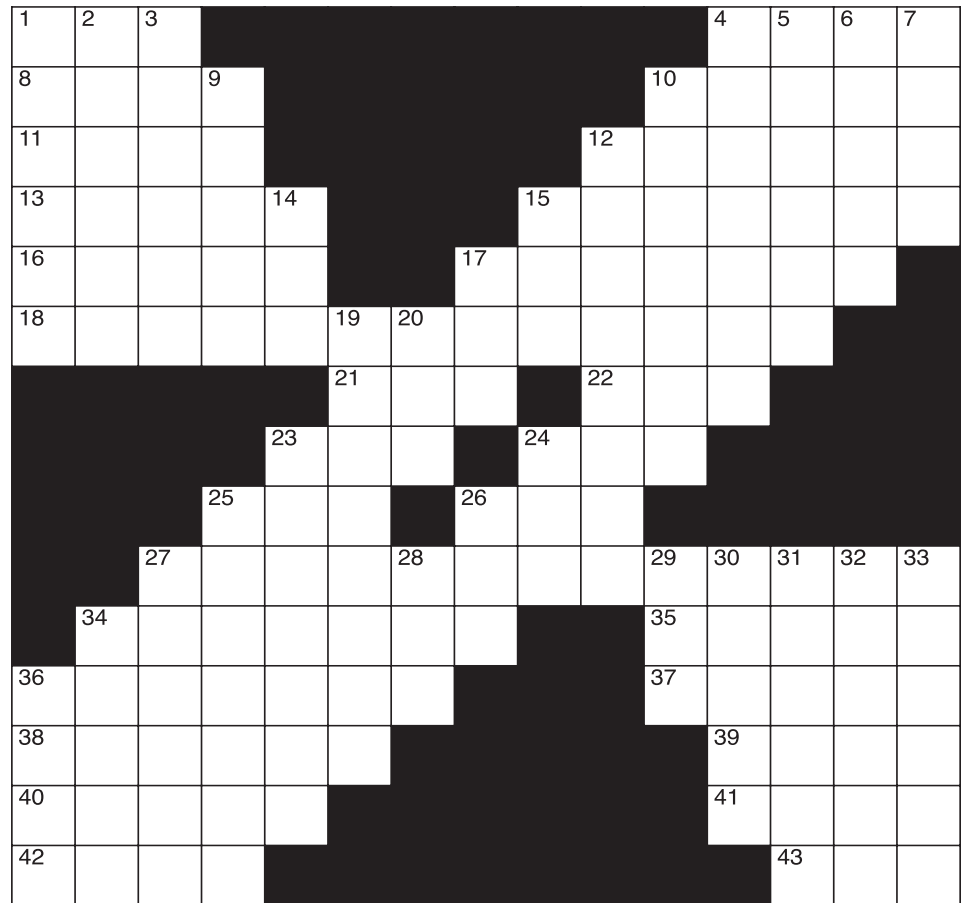

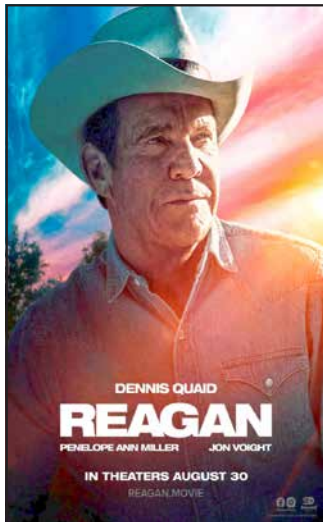
